HOW TO GET STARTED?

What is required to use the Tronsrue Range?

Before you can shoot, you will need to complete an information form, insurance waiver, read and sign the range rules, and watch a safety video. You will need to bring a valid Military/DOD ID card.

Do I have to be military to use the Tronsrue range?

General Public are permitted to use the range during our operating hours, but they must be accompanied by a Military/DOD Sponsor. General Public may attend any of our classes without Military/ DOD sponsorship.

What firearms can I shoot on your range?

Pistols and rifles are permitted. Rifles are limited to .223/5.56 caliber on our 25-yard indoor range. No black powder firearms or shotguns may be used.

What types of ammunition can I use at the range?

We allow up to 7.62x51 NATO (.308cal). <u>PROHIBITED</u>: black powder, steel core ammo (steel cased may be permitted) or tracer. In addition, for safety reasons the TMC RSO may examine and has sole discretion to prohibit the use of ammunition not purchased at TMC.

What types of targets can I use at the range?

Only paper targets may be shot on the range. The range safety officer has final say on what targets may be used at our facility. Targets are available for purchase at the range.

Do I have to buy ammunition at the range, or can I bring my own?

No, you may shoot your own ammunition at our range UNLESS you are using a rental firearm. Ammunition is available for purchase for both rental and personal firearms at the range! However, you must shoot all purchased ammunition during your range session.

Can I bring my children to the range?

We welcome supervised children 12 and over, with a parent or guardian. If minors will be coming with another relative, written parental permission will be required. Children cannot be left unattended at any time.

Do you rent firearms?

Yes! Call for a full list of available rentals or stop by the store!

Can I bring my own firearms?

Yes! Privately Owned Firearms must be first registered with Provost Marshal's Office (PMO) prior to use at Tronsrue Marksmanship Center. Forms are available on our webpage, the range and at PMO.

Can I bring a friend?

Yes, we allow up to 2 people to share 1 port in the range at a time. Bring your friends and share in the experience!

Do I need a Firearms Permit to shoot at the range?

No, however you must bring a Military/DOD ID card.

Are there any restrictions for range use?

Yes! Children 12-15 are restricted to Long Gun usage only; 16-20yrs may use a handgun with the assistance from one of our Pistol Instructors. The minimum age allowed into the range is 12 years old. All persons under 21 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. If a minor will be coming with another relative, written parental permission will be required. Additionally, we recommend to any women who are pregnant that they not use the range due to possible lead exposure. Anyone who is under the influence of drugs or alcohol, acts recklessly or irresponsibly, or has been convicted of a felony will not be permitted to use the range.

What should I wear?

We require both ear and eye protection to be worn in the range. Ear and eye protection is available at no cost. We require closed toe shoes in the range and recommend that you do not wear low cut shirts to avoid getting burned by spent brass casings.

What hours is the range open?

The Tronsrue Marksmanship Center is open for patrons. Saturday – Monday: CLOSED; Tuesday – Wednesday: 10AM - 3PM; Thursday - Friday: 6:30PM - 9PM.

If this is your first time on the range, please arrive at least 1-1/2 hours before closing to complete your paperwork and watch the safety video.

Final range check-in one hour before closing.
